Patient vs. Employee?

Employees are reminded to be aware of their behaviors and actions when they are in the building and are considered a patient or visitor. It is sometimes hard to draw that line, especially when you work here, but we need to remember to shift our behaviors when we aren't here as employees.

If you are here as a patient (either as a patient yourself or with a family member who is a patient) please do not use your employee status for things that other patients cannot. Examples:

- Do not use your name badge to get into areas that patients would not be allowed to enter.
- Do not enter areas of the hospital where patients would not be allowed (i.e. behind registration areas, etc.)
- Make sure you are following visitation guidelines (especially during the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.) At this time if a family member comes in, they are still allowed to ONLY have 1 caregiver.
