Applicants must be:

- Lucas County resident for at least one year.
- 2. High school graduate
- 3. Accepted by an accredited health career school
- 4. The criteria used in selecting grant recipients includes prior academic performance, results of aptitude tests, recommendations from instructors, potential performance as a student in his or her chosen health career field, and financial need.
- 5. Application must be completed and **submitted by April 15th** to LCHC. Please be specific and factual when completing application form.
- 6. Grant Conditions:
 - a. If for any reason the recipient does not complete training, the full amount of the grant is refunded to the LCHC Volunteer Service within 12 months of the person's termination as a full-time student at the academic institution attended.
- 7. No member of the Scholarship Committee shall derive a private benefit. No relative or close friend of any committee member may be selected as a recipient of this grant.
- 8. All material submitted for this application becomes the property of the Lucas County Health Center and will not be returned.

Selection will be made on or before May 1st.
