

VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION

Title/Position: Maintenance Partner

Goal of Position: Support and maintain the facility by assisting the Maintenance Department to complete

indoor and outdoor tasks.

Duties:

1. Work with the Facilities Director to identify tasks to complete, primarily outdoors.

2. Assist with landscaping upkeep by raking leaves, pulling weeds, pruning bushes, maintaining flowerpots, etc.

- 3. Paint outdoor or indoor items as needed.
- 4. Sweep and help keep outdoor sidewalks and doorways clean and clear of debris.
- 5. Willing to pick up trash and other items to maintain the cleanliness outside the facility.
- 6. Identify areas that need extra work and report to Facilities Director.
- 7. Complete other duties as agreed upon by Facilities Director and individual.

Time Frame:

Length of commitment: 12 months and at least one shift per month or weekly shifts over summer

Length of shift: Varied

Scheduling: Varied times and flexible to your schedule. Must be between the hours of 8am

and 4:30pm Monday-Friday. Summer months are preferred.

No Holidays or weekends

Worksite: Mostly outdoors but throughout the entire facility.

Minimum age: 14

- 3. Must be able to read and write
- 4. Good verbal communication skills
